The routes marked in **dark blue** are new walking routes and, in **green**, new cycling routes. Routes in **dark orange** are improvements on existing highways to provide safer facilities for active travel:-

- 1) A new publicly accessible footpath from Combe Steps to Stonesfield Steps along Blenheim Wall (and then to join the public footpath to Akeman Street);
- 2) An extension to the newly accessible footpath (see 1) to enable walkers also to join up with Shakespeare's Way;
- 3) and 4) A new publicly accessible footpath/cycle route to enable walkers and cyclists through Blenheim from Combe Gate to access Hanborough Station;
- 5) and 6) A new cycle path from Combe Gate to Ditchley Gate to enable a safer route to Wootton and also to Woodstock along an improved A44 cycle path;
- 7) A new cycle path along Stonesfield Road/Combe Road to enable better connection for cyclists between Combe and Stonesfield;
- 8) A new cycle path along Woodstock Road for a better (flat!) connection for cyclists between Combe and Stonesfield;
- 9) An upgrade to the existing bridleway between the Evenlode Bridge at the bottom of Swan Hill and Park Road in Hanborough to create a new cycle path for an improved connection between Combe and Hanborough (including to the station).
